

Announcement of a session on “Polymers in Organic Coatings”



Don't forget...abstract submission deadline: January 16, 2026!

Although polymers are part of organic coatings, most of the work presented in the coatings session usually focuses on the interfacial properties of coatings and the development of new coating systems. In comparison, the results presented in the polymer materials session mainly focus on the application and behaviour of bulk structural materials. Therefore, it has become a good tradition to organise a joint session between the two working parties at EUROCORR to bridge the gap between people working on organic coatings on metal surfaces and those working on polymer materials.

Contributions from academics and industry are welcome for this joint session, which could address some of the following points (amongst others):

- Polymer behaviour in organic coatings.
- Main influences on polymers in organic coatings and their consequences on the protective properties of organic coatings.
- Mechanisms of corrosion protection by properties of polymeric materials and appropriate methods of investigation.
- Application cases and experience feedback.
- Inspection and monitoring techniques.
- Etc.
